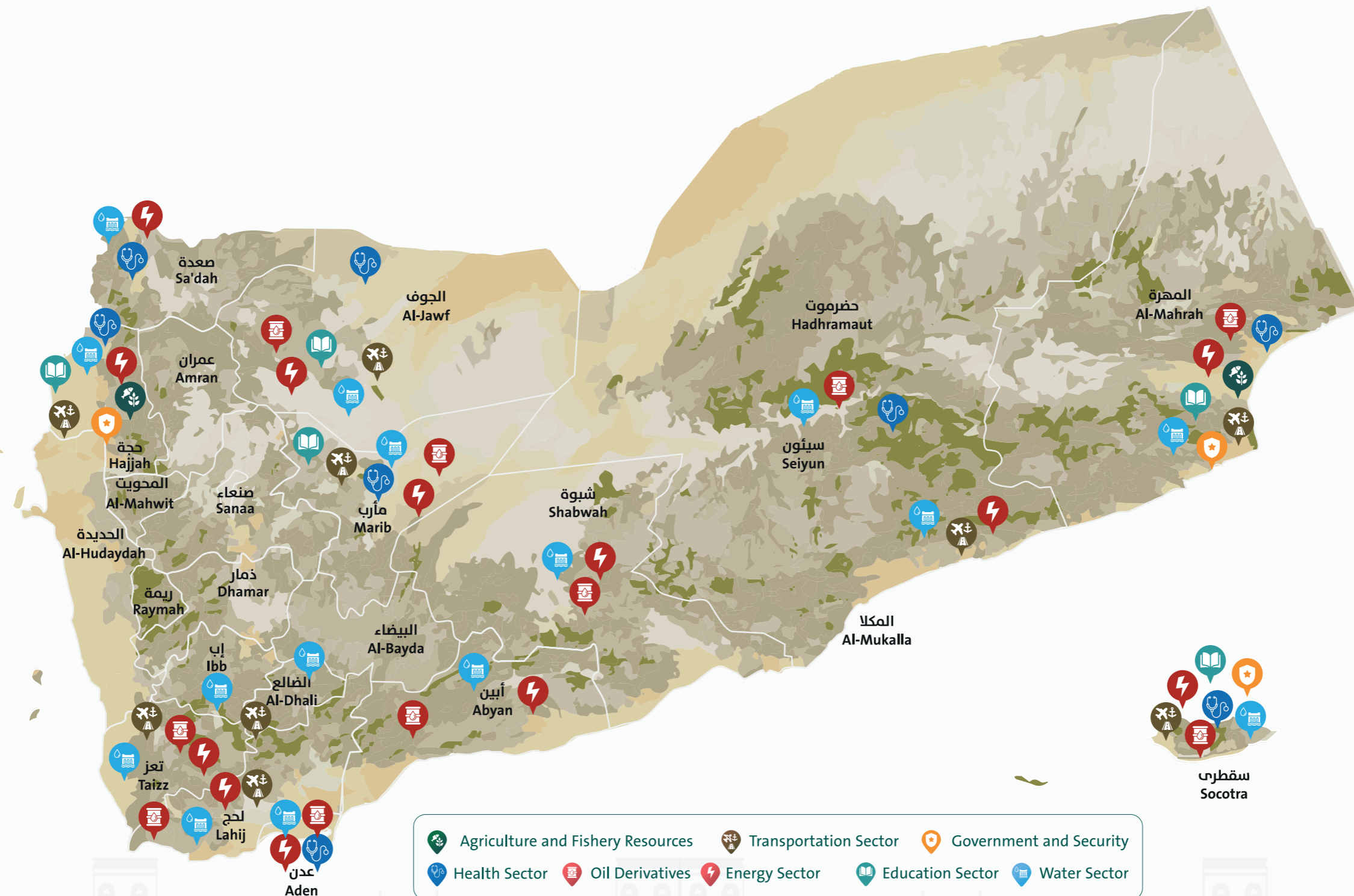

## ENERGY SECTOR

Due to the shortage of electric power sources in Yemen and the frequent power outages, electricity is a very urgent need for Yemenis. Therefore, after assessing the needs, the program is working to supply generators, raise the efficiency of the power stations, use solar energy to conserve the environment and promote sustainability, and supervise the supply and distribution to power stations of oil derivatives from the Kingdom.

- Completed the construction of power stations in Socotra Hajjah provinces.

- Supply of power plants to hospitals
- Streetlights at Al-Ghaydah Airport
- Main road lighting in Hayran district in Hajjah
- Construction of power stations
- Use of solar energy to operate wells.
- Construction of power plants in Benny Fayed, Hajjah province
- Construction of power plants in Hayran, Hajjah province.
- Installing solar powered lightning poles in main roads at Al-Baqaa land crossing in Saada, Hajjah, Marib and Al-Jawf provin

## HEALTH SECTOR

The health sector is essential in Yemen and requires rehabilitation and capacity building. The Saudi Development and Reconstruction Program for Yemen is working to improve and develop the quality and efficiency of healthcare services through the program's various modes of support for the health sector.

- Establishment of a fully equipped dialysis center in Al-Mahra province.
- Rehabilitation of Al-Ghaydah Central Hospital and equipping it with advanced medical instruments in addition to an operating room and intensive care unit (ICU) center.
- Establish a rural hospital in the area of Sayhot and provide it and Qishn Rural Hospital with comprehensive medical equipment.
- Rehabilitation of Aden General Hospital.

- Renovation of the health center in Amadhen, Socotra.
- Renovation of the health center in Nogid, Socotra.
- Provision of advanced medical equipment in Al-Jawf General hospital.
- Furnishing and equipping the health center on Fasht Island in Hajjah province with the latest medical equipment and medicines.
- Provision of ambulances to hospitals in Al-Mahra, Socotra, Al-Jawf, Hadhramaut and Marib provinces.
- Rehabilitation and construction of numerous health facilities in different districts in the provinces of Hadhramaut and Taiz.
- SDRPY has launched an environmental sanitation project in Aden province under the slogan "Beautiful Aden." This project supports the Cleaning and Improvement Fund of Aden, aims to serve 10 residential areas.

## WATER SECTOR

**Yemen suffers from severe water shortages due to the damaged water network & infrastructure. To support this sector, SDRPY works to meet the needs of the Yemeni people and provide clean water supplies by digging wells, provide water tankers, establish conveyer lines and build tank and water dams.**

- Built a water conveyer line connecting Wadi Fouri and Wadi Al-Jiza to Al-Ghaydah in Al-Mahra.
- Excavated 21 wells in Al-Mahra and 6 in Marib.
- Implemented a project to dig and equip 5 new wells and rehabilitated 10 other wells in the Aden.

- Constructing two drinking water tanks with a capacity of 400 and 600 m<sup>3</sup>, and a project to build Daxim dam and water barriers on Socotra Archipelago.
- Supplied 15 water tankers to Al-Mahra, 5 to Socotra, 18 to Marib, 4 to Aden, 10 to Hajjah, 10 to Al-Jawf, 2 to Saada, 3 to Abyan, 3 to Shabwah, 4 to Lahij, 16 to Taiz and 6 to Hadhramaut to facilitate access to clean water.
- Established and equipped a solar-powered well on Fasht island and supplied with two polyethylene tanks (-10,000 10,000,000 liters).

## AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES SECTOR

**Agriculture is a major contributor to the economy in Yemen, both nationally and per capita, and agriculture is the primary source of income for Yemenis. For these reasons, the program is implementing projects that support a variety of methods of diversifying sources of sustainable food production across Yemen's diverse provinces.**

- Construction of greenhouses to enhance food security

- and create job opportunities.
- Deliveries of multi-use agricultural equipment with accessories.
- Cultivation of 120 acres of wheat in Al-Mahra province.
- Provision of 220 fishing boats fully equipped with outboard motors, gear, and refrigerators for fish storage to fishermen in Al-Mahra, Socotra and Hajjah.

## GOVERNMENT ENTITIES

**SDRPY is working with Yemeni provincial authorities to rebuild Yemen's capacity to achieve sustainable security and stability. The program seeks to strengthen Yemeni state institutions through several projects.**

- Renovation and development of Al-Baqaa land crossing.
- Establishment of a counterterrorism building in Al-Mahra.
- Completed the government complex project in Socotra.
- Renovation and outfitting of the coast guard building in

- Hajjah and Al-Mahra.
- Working on the implementation of five security centers in Socotra.
- Working on implementing and restoring five security centers in Al Mahra.
- Completed the design and studies of 5 border security buildings in Al-Mahra, and determine their location with the help of the joint forces and the local authorities in the province.



## TRANSPORTATION SECTOR

**Many Yemeni provinces experience difficulty in moving and accessing essential goods and services, such as healthcare and education. Many Yemenis also find road travel challenging due to rough or unpaved surfaces and poor planning, resulting in traffic accidents. SDRPY is rehabilitating a number of roads, in addition to improving infrastructure for land, sea and air.**

- Rehabilitated Al-Ghaydah International airport and equipped it with RNAV navigations systems and communication devices, in addition to an ambulance and firetruck for airport safety.
- Building Marib Airport (planning phase).
- Rehabilitating Socotra airport and supplying an ambulance and firetruck.

- Rehabilitating Aden Airport which has been provided with two buses, a fire truck and two power generators.
- Development and improvement of Nishtun Port, which was provided with two forklifts of -30ton and -5ton capacity.
- Rehabilitating and equipping Socotra Port, which has been provided with two forklifts of -30ton and -5ton capacity.
- Enhanced public transportation in Socotra with the supply of 8 buses.
- Expanding and rehabilitating the Al-Abar Road linking Ma'rib with the Al-Wadiah land crossing.
- Rehabilitating the Al-Baqaa land crossing in Al-Jawf and a cargo port in Al-Mahra.
- Rehabilitating the internal roads of Socotra Archipelago.

## EDUCATION SECTOR

**Education is key to development. The Saudi Development and Reconstruction Program is supporting learning opportunities for Yemen by implementing development projects that build schools and their facilities, provide school supplies, and provide safe transportation in several Yemeni provinces. This results in a proper educational environment and safe access to education for all students.**

- Built and equipped 8 schools in Al-Mahra, and establishing 4 schools in Socotra, 4 in Aden, 2 in Hadhramaut, 2 in Hajjah, and 1 in Taiz. Schools include facilities, science laboratories, libraries and outdoor yards.

- Provide buses to schools for male and female students and staff: 12 to Al-Mahra, 8 to Socotra, 4 to Marib and 2 to the University of Aden.
- Provided 12,000 school desks and chairs for several schools in Al-Mahra and Socotra.
- Supply over 500,000 textbooks to schools in Al-Mahra and Socotra.
- Construct and equip the Gifted Complex and develop the University of Saba in Marib.
- Assessing and studying the offers of implementation contractors for the King Salman Education and Medical City project in Al-Mahra province.
